Supervisor Jeffrey Shippee called the Public Hearing to order at 7:00 PM. Those presents were Councilors Michele Robillard, Mark Rice, Jan Lennox, Clerk Deborah Bullock, & Highway Superintendent Duane Sykes. Also present were Kathleen Huber, representing the Arts Council, Library and Historical Center; Rich Anson, representing the Fire Department; Don Peck, Morris Gagnon and Joyce Gagnon. Councilor Dianne Hurley was absent.

The Board discussed possible uses of the Covid money the town has received. We are limited to what it can be spent on. Basically, can be used for infrastructure and recreation. The Town of Edwards allocation is \$112,409.91. \$56,205.04 was received in August of 2021. \$8,736.00 has been spent on replacement pumps for the water and sewer. The balance of the allocation is to be paid this summer with the funds to be used by 2024. New playground equipment and a gazebo were discussed as possible uses.
